The scholarships were awarded to Maya G. Pelshaw and Karol Andrzejewski. Maya Pelshaw is a student at the University of Dayton, majoring in Sustainability and Spanish.

Karol Andrzejewski is a student at Central Michigan University pursuing a career in Product Design Engineering Technology.



Richard Tarnicki, President of APCS, made opening remarks emphasizing the importance of education and that we should take pride in the remarkable accomplishments of these students who will be playing important leadership roles in their respective fields. They will undoubtedly continue their participation in Polonian activities.

Barbara Lemecha, Scholarship Committee member recapped that our grant was established decades ago to recognize outstanding full-time Polish American students, to encourage them to strive for excellence in their academic endeavors.

Karol earned the remarkable Seal of Biliteracy, which is an internationally recognized achievement demonstrating truly exceptionable proficiency in 2 languages.


In his essay, he wrote, "Polish Heritage isn't just heritage, it is a way of life. I've been on this wave."
